

.22 Rimfire Challenge

Ruger Rimfire/NSSF Challenge style match.

Participants may enter all six shoots, but only once in each of the six shoots.

Course of Fire:

All shooting is unsupported, offhand, standing at bench facing downrange with firearms at the low ready position (approximately 45 degrees). Reloading, clearing jams, firearm malfunctions etc. count towards total time. NO RE-SHOOTS.

Course is timed fire, shooting four plates ending at the fifth stop plate. Timing stops when the stop plate is hit.

Max time of 30 seconds incurs if any of the four plates are missed and the stop plate is shot, if all the plates are shot but the stop plate is shot out of order or if all five plates are not hit within the 30 second max time allowed.

Handgun:

Targets: Five 8" steel plates are placed at 15 yards.

Scoring: 10 shots maximum, 5 shots minimum per string
4 strings total, worst string not counted.

Starting Signal: Audible

Cease Fire: Audible

Rifle:

Targets: Six 8" steel plates are placed at 24 yards.

Scoring: 10 shots maximum, 5 shots minimum per string
4 strings total, worst string not counted.

Starting Signal: Audible

Cease Fire: Audible

Equipment and Firearms

.22 Rimfire only, no .22 Magnum or any .17 Rimfire.

Ten shot clips, magazines and tube fed only.
