

Three Gun Match

Course of fire

This is a timed match with a moving shooter engaging both static and possibly moving targets in several positions using a rifle, pistol and shotgun during different stages of the match. Targets missed, not engaged or non-targets shot will result in a time penalty. The person with the lowest total time including any penalties will be the winner, the person with the second lowest time will be second place and so on.

Targets consist of a mix of paper, cardboard and steel and are 8" to 24" in a variety of shapes. Distance to the targets will vary from approximately 15 yards to 100 yards.

Safety

Since safety is first and foremost at Council Bluffs Rifle and Pistol Club, Inc. any safety infraction WILL result in INSTANT DISQUALIFICATION.

Equipment Required

- a. Center fire rifle that will accept a magazine holding no less than 10 rounds. A minimum of two magazines are required but 4 magazines suggested. As many as 50 rounds may be required to complete the match without penalty.
- b. Center fire pistol holding a minimum of 10 rounds. A minimum of two magazines are required but 4 magazines suggested. As many as 50 rounds may be required to complete the match without penalty.
- c. Shotgun that will shoot slugs and will accept no less than 2 shells before reloading. A pump or semi-automatic shotgun that accepts 4 shells or more before reloading is suggested. As many as 20 bird shot shells and 10 slugs may be required to complete the match without penalty.
- d. Proper eye and hearing protection is required.
- e. A strong side holster is not required but may help reduce your time if it is deemed possible to use a holster during the match.
